TICKET SALES

- Graduating Seniors will have first opportunity to purchase tickets between 8 AM and 10 AM on April 23rd.
- Early ticket sales are ONLINE ONLY and will be available for purchase on April 23rd at Noon.

- Tickets are \$15 to \$18.

MAKEUP

Makeup is required for each dancer. Stage makeup should be applied heavily as the stage lights wash out dancers' faces. Please ask dressing room moms or an older dancer for help whenever needed. Any dancer at an Intermediate level and up **must wear false eyelashes**. For pictures, dress rehearsal and all performances, dancers should not have any colored nail polish, colored acrylic nails, fake tattoos or jewelry unless specified.

All students must be at each of their tech spots, finale tech, and dress rehearsal.

Please be ready to go, **in costume** ready to dance at your required time. Doors will open for Tech at 8:30am. Please have hair ready upon arrival. **Makeup is not needed for Tech but is required for Dress Rehearsal** (photos!).

Parents are not permitted to watch TECH or DRESS Rehearsals and are asked to wait in the cafeteria - NOT in the wings.

During Dress Rehearsal, all parents who will be working backstage for a show MUST be present.

Early is on time. On time is late. Late is unacceptable.

During Full Dress rehearsal, students may leave once they are finished with their last number and have been dismissed by their teacher.

If your child has been selected for a Student Of The Month or Star Award, she/he will need to stay for that during Dress Rehearsal as well.

We will not run FINALE at the end of Dress.

You MUST clean and check your space before leaving the school.

This year we will have 2 nights of recital run through at the studio. We need anyone who is working backstage (dressing room or runners) to be present on Wednesday. We will treat this just a dress rehearsal on stage. The tap room will be the "holding room" for Creative Dance through Beginners.

WHAT YOU NEED IN YOUR DANCE BAG TO SURVIVE TECH, DRESS AND PERFORMANCE

Dancers always need to be prepared, so make sure you have everything you could need in case of injury, fatigue, costume fixing, or bun making!

- Bottled water
- Neat & healthy snacks
- Sports tape
- Band aids
- Lots of bobby pins
- Hair ties
- Hair nets
- Hair spray
- Brush
- Masking tape for toes
- Ace wrap
- Ibuprofen
- Sewing kit
- Theraband
- Icy hot
- Tennis ball
- Extra leotard
- Extra tights
- Blanket & pillow for the little ones
- Patience, patience & more patience!

HAIR

Hairnets are required for ALL buns and should be the same color as your child's hair. These are available at the front desk. Please see the costume board in the hallway for your child's hairstyle. *PRO-TIP:* Before pulling hair up in pony tail, spray liberally with hairspray. This will help the hairs grip together as you brush back into ponytail keeping wispies at a minimum.

COSTUMES

All costumes need to be steamed/ironed before pictures and performances. Please make sure that **ALL costumes and accessories are labeled with your dancer's name**. Shoes should be labeled *inside* of the shoe and not on the bottom. Please see the costume wall in the hallway of the studio which lists all of the extras your dancer will need. One pair of the appropriate color tights are included with your costume. Extra pairs of tights and shoes can be purchased at the studio to save you a trip to a dancewear supplier. **We will be placing an order for tights and shoes on May 6.** Order sheet is on the front desk.

If you choose to buy tights on your own you will need:

Ballet: T90 Balera in Ballet Pink

Tan Tights: T90 Balera in Light Suntan

DRESSING ROOM RULES

- ⇒ Dancers are not to leave the dressing room during the show.
- ⇒ **ALL STUDENTS MUST REMAIN BACKSTAGE DURING INTERMISSION** and no one will be allowed entry to backstage during intermission.
- ⇒ Only water is allowed in dressing rooms. **NO FOOD OR OTHER DRINKS!!** Food dyes and expensive costumes don't mix!
- ⇒ **No guests are permitted backstage.** Only 1 parent per dancer is permitted backstage for drop off/pick up due to space constraints. For the safety of all of our dancers, there are to be no males in the female dressing rooms.

PARENT HELPERS

It takes an army to make the show run smoothly! Parents/guardians are needed in dressing rooms, as stage crew, and in other areas. Helpers will only be expected to work one show. Every parent/guardian will have the opportunity to sit and watch one performance without any interruption. Please find your name and remember to buy tickets for the show you are NOT helping. If you have a conflict with the show you are helping, please try to resolve it by finding another member of the family to help or by asking another parent to switch with you.

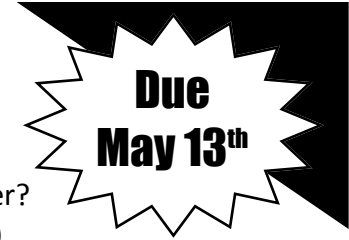
