You have been invited to join TPDC in their production of The Wizard of Oz! Costumes will be provided by TPDC or use your child's recital costume, parents are only responsible for shoes and tights. This a great performance opportunity for each child and we look forward to seeing them shine onstage!

Enclosed in this packet you should find everything you need to know about this production. Parents/guardians are needed as helpers backstage, in dressing rooms, and other areas. All parents/guardians will have one show to watch the performance uninterrupted. Parents, if you are unable to help you **MUST** find someone who can fill in for you. It takes a huge group effort to put on a production and we rely on our helpers to make the show run smoothly!

Please keep in mind the following:

1. Participation in this performance is not a requirement. **If your child does not want to participate, please let Kat know immediately so that she can adjust choreography.** However, if your child will be joining us, they must be present at all rehearsals assigned. Anyone who misses 2 or more rehearsals will be unable to participate in the performance.
2. All shoes are to be labeled *inside* of the shoe and not on the bottom.
3. Dancers are not to leave the dressing room during the show. **ALL STUDENTS MUST REMAIN BACKSTAGE**
4. **DURING INTERMISSION.** They may greet their guests after each performance in the theatre or front hallway. **Please do not bring guests into the backstage area** (girls changing, props/costumes moving, it's crowded).
5. **ONLY** water is allowed in dressing rooms. Children may only snack *outside* of the dressing rooms if they are **NOT** in costume **AND** are supervised.
6. Make up is required for each dancer. Please ask dressing room moms or an older dancer for help if needed.
7. Any dancer at an Intermediate level and up **MUST** wear false eyelashes.
8. For pictures, dress rehearsal and all performances, dancers should not have any colored nail polish, fake tattoos or jewelry unless specified for their costume.
9. Hairnets are required and should be the same color as your child's hair.
10. All dancers will need to have the same color tights (Balera T90 in Ballet Pink) and clean ballet slippers unless otherwise specified for your role (Miss Kat will notify you if this pertains to you). Tights and shoes can be purchased by placing your order at the front desk by Feb 3.

This is a huge production and all help is needed and greatly appreciated.
